"When King Herod and all Jerusalem heard about this, they became disturbed. He called together all the chief priests and the experts in the Scriptures and tried to find out from them where the Messiah was supposed to be born. They told him, 'In Bethlehem in Judea. The prophet wrote about this: Bethlehem in the land of Judah, you are by no means least among the leaders of Judah. A leader will come from you. He will shepherd my people Israel."

"Then Herod secretly called the wise men and found out from them exactly when the star had appeared. As he sent them to Bethlehem, he said, 'Go and search carefully for the child. When you have found him, report to me so that I may go and worship him too.""

"After they had heard the king, they started out. The star they had seen rising led them until it stopped over the place where the child was. They were overwhelmed with joy to see the star. When they entered the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary. So they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasure chests and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. God warned them in a dream not to go back to Herod. So they left for their country by another road."



We celebrate Christmas because it is about the birth of Jesus! This baby became a man who loved everyone and taught us how God wants us to live. He gave His life to pay for our sins, and was raised to life three days later. Jesus wants to give us the greatest gift of all, eternal life! We can read in the Bible about how we can accept Jesus as our Savior, and receive the best Christmas present ever!


