We will also eat breakfast and perhaps lunch on the road during trip home.

## Volunteer Background Check

Before work assignments are given, an on-site background check will be conducted. This process will require a driver's license or other government issued PHOTO ID for each volunteer. This check will matched and scanned with National Sex Offender and Child Custody registries.
